January 2024 luncheon (15 attendees, including 6 AMWA members)

Business consultant Susan Ryan of SC Ryan Consulting LLC presented "Best Practices for Working Remotely" to the group on January 10th. She provided ideas for individuals, managers, and organizations as to how to stay connected and engaged with their coworkers when they are not physically co-located.
